Black and White/Color photos must be 8x10, mounted on 11x14.

Picture Story entries must consist of 3 to 6 photos mounted on 11x14 and should depict a sequence or communicate a message.

Photographs in this category are taken with either a digital, manual, or point-and-shoot camera, and printed either at a chemical processing lab or on a digital printer.
