## **Angelina County Farm Bureau Scholarship Opportunities due March 1**

The Angelina County Farm Bureau has established the following (2) scholarships.

- (1) Angelina County Farm Bureau Scholarship in Memory of Mack Little is available to Farm Bureau members as outlined in Students Eligible to Apply criteria excluding eligible relatives of board members, employees or staff directly affiliated with Angelina Farm Bureau.
- (2) Angelina County Farm Bureau Scholarship in Honor of Fred Hartmann is available to Farm Bureau members as outlined in Students Eligible to Apply criteria including only eligible relatives of board members, employees or staff directly affiliated with Angelina Farm Bureau.

**Purpose of the Scholarship(s):** The purpose of the Angelina County Farm Bureau Scholarships are to express the interest of the Angelina County Farm Bureau in its members and their families, to promote agriculture, to promote higher education, and to honor Mack Little and Fred Hartmann.

**Number of Scholarships:** The chosen student or students will receive a one-year scholarship in the amount to be determined by the board.

**Students Eligible to Apply for a Scholarship:** Any student is eligible to apply but must be either a current 4H or FFA member and have been a member for at least two (2) years. Also, whose parent(s) has been a Angelina County Farm Bureau member in good standing for two (2) years by the time the student registers for his/her senior year in high school. Any student whose step-parent meets the above specifications and who is claimed by that step-parent as a dependent under the Internal Revenue Code is eligible to apply.

**High School Grade Required:** In order to be considered for a scholarship, the applicant must have an average grade of no less than 80 out of 100 percentage points for the four years of high school. In addition, the student must graduate from an accredited Angelina County High School.

When to apply: Applications for a scholarship must be submitted by March 1st of the student's senior year of high school.

**How to apply:** Students applying for a scholarship must file with the Youth Committee of the Angelina County Farm Bureau Board of Directors the following documents:

- I. A completed application form.
- II. An official transcript of the 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and first semester of the 12<sup>th</sup> grade years.

- III. A paragraph consisting of 100 words or more stating "What Agriculture Has Meant to Me."
- IV. Listing of Extracurricular Activities (list of school clubs or organizations to which you belong, office held, any special honors received, etc.)
- V. Listing of Community Service Involvement

**Scholarship Committee:** Each year the Board of Directors will appoint a Scholarship Committee that will evaluate the qualifications of the applicants.

**How Scholarship Winners are Determined:** The Scholarship Committee based on submission of required documentation will evaluate the qualifications of each applicant.

**Announcement of Awards:** On or before March 15<sup>th</sup>, the Scholarship Committee will receive from the Youth Committee of Angelina County Farm Bureau all of the submitted applications, high school transcripts, and letters of recommendation, etc. Prior to April 1<sup>st</sup>, the Scholarship Committee will determine which of the applicants will receive scholarships and submit the names of these recipients to the Board of Directors, which in turn will make the appropriate announcement.

<u>College Selection:</u> Students who are awarded scholarships may attend any college provided it is an accredited college or university in good standing. Upon receiving notice of a scholarship award, the recipient must contact the Youth Committee of Angelina County Farm Bureau to inform them of the selected school.

**Amount of Scholarship:** Each scholarship total is to be determined annually, payable upon proof of enrollment to an accredited college or university within a twelve (12) month period from date of scholarship receipt.

<u>How the Scholarship is Paid:</u> Payment will be made by check to the student after approval by the Board of Directors and receipted documentation for enrollment in an accredited college or university has been provided to the Board of Directors.

<u>Cancellation of Scholarship:</u> Recipients must provide the Board of Directors with receipted documentation of enrollment within the given time frame of twelve (12) months. Failure to do so will result in cancellation of the scholarship.

**Awards are made only to Eligible Applicants:** Awards will be made only when there are eligible applicants.

**Duration of Scholarship Plan:** The Angelina County Farm Bureau Board of Directors wishes this scholarship plan to continue indefinitely and believes that it may. The Board also realizes that conditions may change in the future; therefore, the Board reserves the right to modify or terminate the plan, in whole or part, whenever and in whatever manner it may determine.
