Who can participate: Angelina County youth that are bonafide members of a 4-H or FFA club in Angelina County.

Entry Fee: \$70.00 per contestant covers range fees and clay targets

Entry Deadline: February 27th at www.AngelinaCountyFair.com

Entry Requirements:

1. You must be a bona fide member of a ANGELINA County 4-H or FFA club.
2. All participants must attend the required safety meeting on the day of competition.
3. All participants must have a parent or assigned guardian present during the competition.
4. Signed Liability Release turned in at competition check in. (this will be emailed to all registered participants after the entry deadline)

Contest Includes:

- ☐ 25 Skeet, 5 Stand, 50 Sporting Clay
- ☐ Points awarded toward High Point Individual and Team in each Age Group.
- ☐ Teams will consist of 4 members from the same club/chapter. Team members will be turned in at check in the morning of the competition.

Age Groups:

- ☐ Junior – 3-5th grade
- ☐ Intermediate – 6-8th grade
- ☐ Senior 1 - 9-10th grade
- ☐ Senior 2- 11-12th grade

Prizes: Awards will be given for Top 3 Individuals in each division and high point teams in each age group.

Awards will be presented at the conclusion of the contest. Estimated time will be announced on contest day. Scores from shotgun and archery are ranked to award a Top Sportsman in each age group with buckles.

What to bring

Gun: 12, 20, 28 gauge. No home defense shotguns allowed. Modified barrels must have supporting documentation from the gunsmith.

Ammo: Sizes allowed are listed in the rules. No reload ammunition allowed.

Clothing: Regulation eye and ear protection and closed toed shoes are required.

Rules: *The Shotgun contest is subject to the ACF General Rules* and will follow the current Texas 4-H Shotgun rules found at the link on our website. www.AngelinaCountyFair.com/faq/
